Meeting Recap – 6/30/26

Volunteers

A. Volunteer lanyards and ID tags: Done, on the way for the meet.

B. Volunteer coordination: A system is being developed to balance volunteer and officiating duties across teams. Officiating commitments must be submitted one week before the meet to count toward volunteer credit; once team numbers are confirmed, jobs needed and officials signed up will be used to generate assignments.

C. Announcer recruitment: Stefan will cover Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights. I still need someone for Thursday night and the 10-and-under session; considering reaching out to teens or teams directly.

Awards breaks

Awards will happen after every four events, with about 10-minute breaks for cool-down. Relay awards will be given right after morning events instead of waiting. Medley relays for Saturday will run at the beginning and end of the day. Athletes will be pre-medaled in the ready room to keep the podium moving.

Facility rules and swimmer seating

Teams will be assigned specific seating sections, with banners removed after the Senior meet. Chair situation still unresolved. Air quality and temperature in overflow areas (including concerns about the hockey rink) are being checked with Wesleyan facilities.

Safety

Two male and two female marshals will patrol locker rooms every 30 minutes to help monitor the boys' bathroom and reduce facility damage. Will also confirm requirements with the Safe Sport coordinator.

Other items

Bonus 50 freestyle events for relay-only swimmers are being added, pending approval from Steve and Prog.Ops. Sunday night catering will repeat last time's playbook, including Chinese food.
